The current design increases speeds around the Burke Rd. curve and as designed will likely increase speeds along the rest of Burke Road. This project, without considering the complex transportation dynamics along the entire Burke Rd. inadequately meets the needs for Burke Road.</p>
<p>Are there any concerns that you feel have not been addressed?</p>	<p>Yes <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> No ___</p> <p>Comments: Interconnected sidewalks, bike lanes and trails are a large part of the proposed design; however, as proposed creates complex, confusing and dangerous pedestrian, biker and vehicle interactions. Primarily the vehicle speeds along with the designed pedestrian and bike crossing around the curve create dangerous and unsafe conditions for the community residents and commuters.</p>
<p>Please provide us with any additional information which you feel would assist in the design/completion of this project.</p>	<p>Comments: Bring the community into the next design phase of the project incorporate community concerns and project outcomes that satisfy resident concerns first while satisfying infrastructure, traffic, pedestrian, and bicycle needs. The current proposed design provides sidewalks, bike lanes, trails and flood control measures, all are desirable. However, the proposal also increases speeds around the curve significantly and to the detriment of local residents. Reducing Burke Rd. speeds is the primary resident concern and remains unresolved</p>
